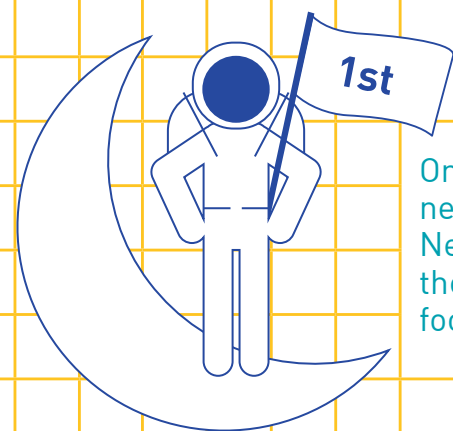

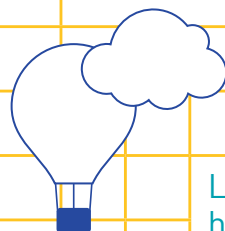


Space is three times colder than the coldest place on Earth, Antarctica.



On 20 July 1969 (that's nearly 50 years ago!) Neil Armstrong was the first person to set foot on the Moon.

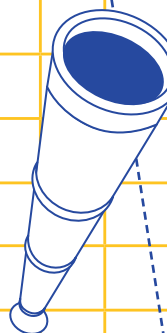
The first hot-air balloon was made in 1783 and flew over Paris.



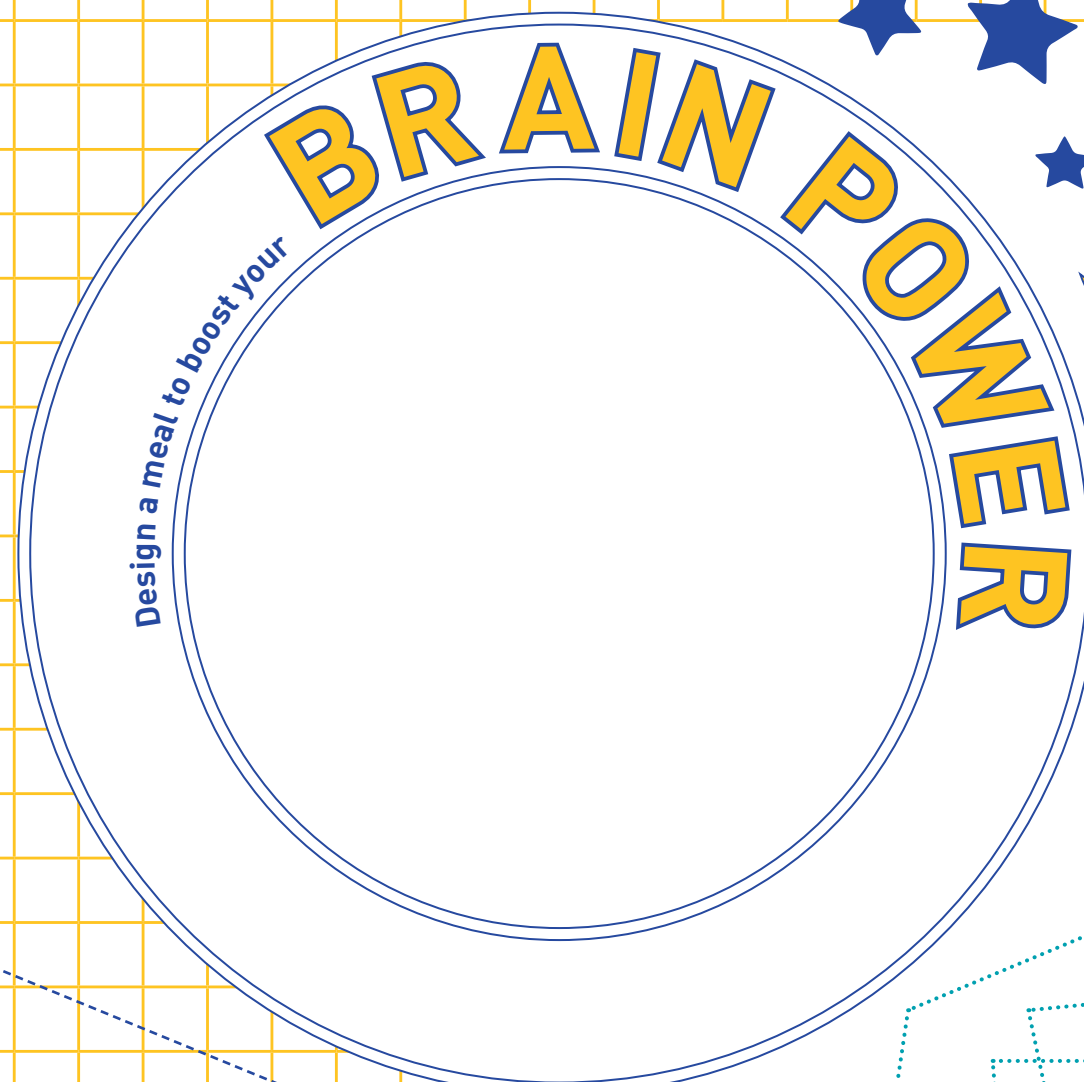
Lightning is five times hotter than the Sun and is a form of static electricity.



In 1930 Amy Johnson became the first woman to fly solo from Britain to Australia.



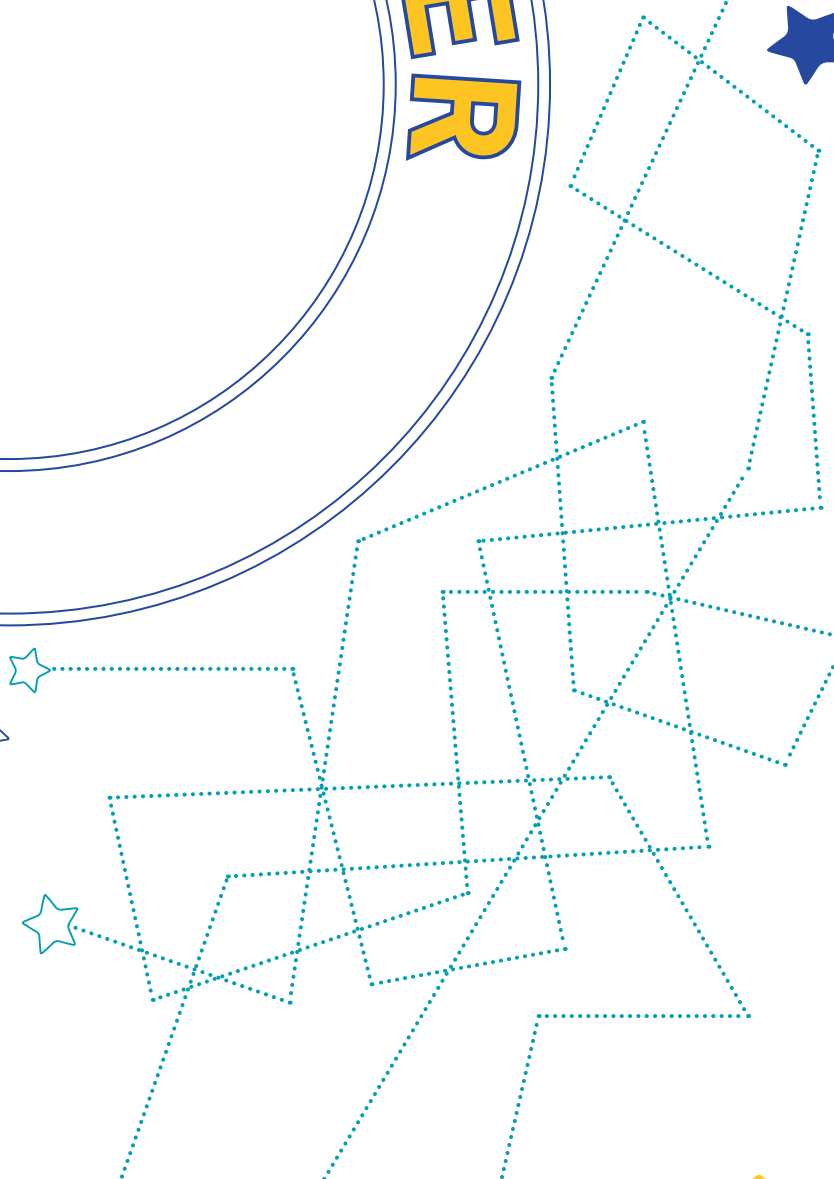
